- Improve teacher capability through the powerful use of student data, planning, observation and moderation to support students' progression of learning.
- Increase our curriculum achievement for English from 86.4% to 88% A-C in Semester 1, 2022.
- Increase the percentage of Year 3 students obtaining National Minnimum Standards (NMS) in Writing to 90% and Year 5 students obtaining NMS in Writing to 88%.
- Increase our percentage of Year 3 students in the Upper Two Bands (U2B) in Writing to 32% and our Year 5 students in the U2B in Writing to 12%.

- Providing regular opportunities for teachers to meet with members of the leadership team to analyse and discuss student data and continue to grow a coaching and feedback culture within our school.
